Dear Parent/Guardian,

At St. Fiacc's we operate a **Book Rental Scheme**. This means that everything "paper based"...textbooks, copies, notebooks, folders etc. ... is purchased through the school and because we buy in bulk, we are able to buy these goods at a discount.

We are sending this letter out at an earlier stage to facilitate easy payment through instalments, taking into account financial pressures on parents. Also, there are timelines to be met with regard to ordering books and so it is very important that dates are adhered to.

As you are aware, the initiative has many **benefits** for example **Photocopying**, **Art & Crafts & Insurance Money are all included in this bill.**

To run this scheme, we need 100% participation and 100% payment.

Thankfully, the bills for each class's Book Scheme will remain the same as it was last year. Therefore the bills stand as follows : **Ninety euros per child (€90)**

Easy Payment Plan

- The money will be collected during the months of May & beginning of June. The first payment will be accepted from today, May 4th. All bills must be cleared by the 17th June 2022.
- Payment can be made through Aladdin Connect or by placing the money in an envelope with your child's name, current class and current class teacher's name and is to be dropped in to the school secretary. Full Payment due by 17th June 2022.

We ask for your cooperation in ensuring that the installments are paid in full & on time.

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Terms & Conditions

The books supplied under the scheme will remain at all times the property of the school. They will be subject to inspection at any time by any member of the teaching staff.

If books are lost or damaged, full compensation for lost books will be required before readmission to the scheme.

Membership of the scheme is at the discretion of the Principal. Any student found to be abusing or defacing rented books will be dismissed from the scheme and will be required to supply their own books for the remainder of their time in school.

Books supplied under the scheme may be new or second hand at the discretion of the Principal.
