## NOTE RE COLLECTING A CHILD FROM SCHOOL

Children may not be removed early from class unless for HSE appointment or family emergency. The removal from class causes significant disruption to classes and the running of the school. In the event that a child has a HSE appointment:

- 1. Inform teacher and Secretary via Aladdin/email
- 2. Teacher arranges for the pupil to be at the office for collection.
- 3. Pupil is signed out by parent
- 4. All early removals are recorded on Aladdin

Yard time (10.50-11.10 & 12.50-1.10)

Due to unavailability of staffing during yard times, pupils cannot be removed from yard for early collection so prior notice of HSE appointment is required
