<p><b>Narrative</b> The children will be enabled to;</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● JI will write familiar stories pictorially in a sequence of three</li> <li>● SI will sequence stories pictorially and write a sentence to match each picture of 4 / 5 pictures.</li> <li>● SI will use who, where and what to compose a simple story.</li> <li>● Teacher will read simple stories eg fairy tales</li> <li>● Teacher will model narrative writing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Teacher will teach Narrative writing genre using the 7 Step Writing Process</li> <li>● Use a simple narrative plan: title; setting; characters, events, problem, resolution, conclusion</li> <li>● Use a template to plan their stories,</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Continued use of narrative template</li> <li>● Use the following devices:  <b>Setting</b> (Who? Where? When?)  <b>Initiating event</b> (How did the characters get involved?)  <b>Problem</b> (What was the conflict/problem?)  <b>Resolution</b> (How was the problem solved?)  <b>Tense</b> (Past tense)  <b>Characters</b> (Are characters defined?)  <b>Description</b> (is descriptive language used to create images?)  <b>Linking words</b> (to do with time)</li> <li>● Use <b>paragraphs</b> to reflect different parts(4th Class)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Recall all elements and strategies used in narrative writing to date.</li> <li>● Describe a character with particular emphasis on personality rather than appearance.</li> <li>● Describe a detailed setting using visualisation strategies.</li> </ul>
